

Behaviour and Emotional Health Team - Service Update October 2024

Our team is the starting point of the referral pathway for children where there are queries regarding possible neurodevelopmental conditions such as Autism (ASD) and/or Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD) who are registered with a Nottingham City GP.

Wait Times



An upwards trend in referrals continues and therefore demands on the pathway and team. The team accepted 893 (avg 149 per month) of new referrals from April-September 2024. Current wait times, from the date of referral to triage, is currently a minimum of 12 months. This increase was expected due to some proactive and child centred initiatives within the team which included accelerating children that were in Year 6 and therefore completing the non-clinical element of the assessment before the Summer break. The team is in the process of trialling a new approach to triaging referrals which we anticipate will trigger significant improvements to our wait times..

Referral Acknowledgement/Unable to acceptance

We aim to screen ALL referrals made to the team within **2-3 weeks** of receipt and confirm if the referral can be accepted or not.

A high volume of referrals are <u>not</u> accepted, approximately 100 per month*. This is *not* based on the child's referred for needs rather that mandatory fields have not been completed or supporting documents and assessments provided.

We appreciate the support from our referring community and request that you continue to submit fully completed referrals with supporting documents and assessments that will aid our Non-Clinical assessment.
