Change to Moderation Process

A change to the moderation process will come into effect ahead of the main HLN/SEND Funding panel which takes place in January 2025. These changes will therefore affect the moderation process which takes place in preparation for this panel in October and November 2024. It will not affect the moderation for the September interim panel 2024, which will take place as normal.

The changes for October and November 2024 and moving forwards will be:

- Settings will now be required to have 10% of their bids moderated, rather than all bids
- All settings will need to have a minimum of 1 bid moderated
- Settings must select their own bids for moderation, ideally these should be of different primary need or new bids where possible
- Moderations will continue in the same way through a visit, telephone call or Team's meeting.

It is hoped that the following changes will help to streamline the moderation process, bring greater consistency and help build capacity in settings as well as support teams
