Nottingham City Council is planning to improve your road

We are resurfacing Shakespeare Street between South Sherwood Street and Mansfield Road. Work will begin on 26th August until 9th September 2025. Hours of work will be 8pm to 6am. Please see information below and plan overleaf for further details.

How will this affect you?

All Phases

- All restrictions are in operation during working hours only.
- Pedestrian footways will always remain in use.
- Eastbound traffic maintained, westbound traffic to follow diversion.
- Traffic enforcement cameras will not be in use during working hours to allow access to diversion routes.
- Buses will use the diversion routes. Please see Nottingham City Transport website for further details of this www.nctx.co.uk/service-updates
- No parking, loading or unloading to take place during the works.
- Access to North Church Street please follow the diversion.

Phase 1 – 26th August to 31st August (works area south side of Shakespeare Street)

- You will still be able to travel eastbound. Westbound traffic follows diversion.

Phase 2 – 2nd September to 9th September (works area north side of Shakespeare Street)

- You will still be able to travel eastbound. Westbound traffic follows diversion.
