1. Minutes of the last meeting

2. Listening campaign feedback

Students from Farnborough Academy gave a presentation and feedback from their recent training and listening campaign. The training was arranged with NTU as part of the work of the Collective Impact project, and facilitated by Nottingham Citizens. The students then answered questions from board members about the detail in the presentation and what interventions they wanted to see the board focus on. Students were thanked for their time and energy, and invited to stay to listen to the draft vision and objectives.

3. Vision planning and future meetings

Matt Wheatley presented the draft vision and objectives, referencing the survey results, data presented previously by NTU and the work the board have done on developing the vision.

Agreed to confirm vision and objectives at the following meeting. All board members requested to comment via email in advance of the meeting their comments and/ or agreement if they are not able to attend.

Discussed criteria for information to be submitted to DLUHC by 1/8/24. We are still waiting for templates for the documentation to be signed off and passed to us, but still working to deadline.

Next meeting will focus on Heritage, high streets and regeneration theme.

4. Safety and security

Insp Steve Dalby introduced himself, and presented on crime and policing in the neighbourhood, as well as costings for a range of interventions that board members may wish to consider. Discussion on merits of

some of the interventions, and longevity/ sustainability. Area has already benefited from Safer Streets 5 funding that covers some of the area of the Town Board, and proposed interventions will follow on/wrap around that work. To be confirmed at next meeting.

Discussed need for costings for items in addition to the ones presented at the meeting – Claire to send out costings that have been received as an indicator before agreement to commit funding.
