Service Definitions

Day Service

A day service is defined as a support/activity service provided during the day (including evening) for the purpose of delivering outcomes specified in the attendee's support plan and to provide respite for a service user's carer.

A day service would ordinarily be utilised to enhance a person's life through social interaction, opportunities to be independent and experiences to encourage self-realisation. They might also specifically offer a safe environment for a vulnerable person and/or a means of providing personal care. It is expected that day services would normally take place away from the home environment.

Within this definition day services can be categorised in two separate ways:

Day Care:

Where activity takes place predominantly in a specific fixed building

Where activity typically takes place in a group setting

Where the daily timetable starts and finishes at the same time each day

Day Opportunities:

Where the service is delivered in variable community locations

Where the service is delivered to an individual

Where activities are led by individual citizen choice

Service Aim

Through organised, meaningful activities, the service should promote some or all of the following:







Time Out is a home care agency set up in 1995 and has a specialism in providing high quality services to Nottingham's black and minority (BME)

Time Out provides both home care and respite care, which is a service to give informal carers a much deserved break. At any one time we have about 60 clients and employ more than 30 staff. We deliver a service to both the city and county

and more than half the people we help pay via personal budgets.

We now run a Day Care service from Balisier Court, a sheltered housing project in St Anns which has recently been improved and upgraded.

This service aims to give users a new lease of life by offering far more than a traditional day centre or luncheon club. We offer a wide range of activities that includes recreation, education and healthy living. For example, one afternoon we may run an advice 'workshop' on healthy diets, with opportunities to cook and sample; another day may be about using computers to contact far away friends and relations. 
