



Nottingham City Council Act 2003 – Occasional Sales

Record of Attendance – multiple entries – to be completed by sales organiser or his/her representative

The Nottingham City Council Act 2003 came into force on 1st April 2004 and requires holders of occasional sales to record all sellers who attend. It is a criminal offence to record false information. Those who intentionally provide false details could be prosecuted and are liable on conviction to a max. fine of £2500.
