- **Films:** no licence is required for 'not-for-profit' film exhibition held in community premises between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day provided that the audience does not exceed 500 and the organiser (a) gets consent to the screening from a person who is responsible for the premises; and (b) ensures that each such screening abides by age classification ratings.
- **Indoor sporting events:** no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000.
- **Boxing or Wrestling Entertainment:** no licence is required for a contest, exhibition or display of Greco-Roman wrestling, or freestyle wrestling between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000. Combined fighting sports – defined as a contest, exhibition or display which combines boxing or wrestling with one or more martial arts – are licensable as a boxing or wrestling entertainment rather than an indoor sporting event.
- **Live music:** no licence permission is required for:
 - o a performance of unamplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, on any premises.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a workplace that is not licensed to sell alcohol on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.
- **Recorded Music:** no licence permission is required for:
 - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
 - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school proprietor or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.

- Dance: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 500. However, a performance which amounts to adult entertainment remains licensable.
- Cross activity exemptions: no licence is required between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, with no limit on audience size for:
 - o any entertainment taking place on the premises of the local authority where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the local authority;
 - o any entertainment taking place on the hospital premises of the health care provider where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the health care provider;
 - o any entertainment taking place on the premises of the school where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the school proprietor; and
 - o any entertainment (excluding films and a boxing or wrestling entertainment) taking place at a travelling circus, provided that (a) it takes place within a moveable structure that accommodates the audience, and (b) that the travelling circus has not been located on the same site for more than 28 consecutive days.

Proposed Variation: To extend the hours of Late Night Refreshment from 23:00 to 03:00 hrs to 23:00 to 05:00 hrs, Monday to Sunday.

1. General - All Four Licensing Objectives

GDK Nottingham has operated successfully under its current licence (23:00 - 03:00 hrs) since November 2023.

- Clean Record: Verified 12-month history with zero police call-outs, zero ASB reports, and zero resident complaints.
- Rebuttal to Saturation Zone: We are an existing, compliant operator. Extending to 05:00 hrs will reduce cumulative impact by smoothing the dispersal of customers (avoiding the 03:00 hrs rush) rather than adding to it.

Measures for the Extended Hours (03:00 - 05:00 hrs)

The following measures apply specifically to the new 03:00 - 05:00 hrs window to ensure the licensing objectives are promoted:

- Enhanced Security: Two (2) SIA-licensed door supervisors will be present from 23:00 to 05:00 hrs daily.
- Dispersal: Staff will actively manage the exit of customers to ensure a quiet, orderly departure, coordinating with local taxi firms.
- Noise Control: Strict enforcement of "no music" and "closed doors" policies continues through to 05:00 hrs.

2. The Prevention of Crime and Disorder

Security (SIA Staff - Enhanced Provision)

- Mandatory Deployment: Two (2) SIA-licensed door supervisors will be on duty from 23:00 to 05:00 hrs daily.
 - Positioning: One supervisor will be stationed at the main entrance to control access and monitor the queue. The second supervisor will patrol the immediate exterior and manage the dispersal of customers leaving the premises.
 - Ratio: This provides a robust security presence (2 staff) for the late-night period, exceeding standard requirements for a food-led venue.
- Function: To prevent disorder, manage entry/exit, check for weapons/drugs, and ensure orderly dispersal.
- Log: A record of both staff names, SIA licence numbers, and contact details will be kept on-site and available to Police immediately upon request.
- Badges: Both supervisors will wear clearly displayed SIA badges.

CCTV & Recording

- Coverage: Internal areas, entrance, exit, and immediate external vicinity.
- Retention: Footage retained for 31 days in unedited format.
- Access: Trained staff available to download footage immediately upon request.

Incident & Refusal Logging

- Incident Book: Records of disorder, damage, injuries, or drug activity. Retained for 12 months.
- Refusal Book: Records of refusals of admission/service. Retained for 12 months.
- Delivery Log: All deliveries recorded (recipient, address, time, driver name). Delivered only to residential/business addresses.

Drug & Weapon Policy

- Zero Tolerance: Strict policy against drugs and weapons. Staff trained to recognise signs of drug activity.
- Toilet Inspections: Regular, documented inspections to prevent misuse.
- Emergency Alarm: Red-line connection to emergency services.

3. Public Safety

Staff Training

- Frequency: Intensive initial training and refresher training every 6 months.
- Topics: Conflict resolution, recognising drugs/weapons, fire safety, safeguarding.
- Records: Detailed logs maintained for every employee.

Fire Safety & Layout

- Evacuation: Clear fire escape routes signposted and kept unobstructed.
- Capacity: Safe capacity limits enforced. No overcrowding.
- First Aid: Equipment available; staff trained in basic first aid.

Lighting & Ventilation

- Lighting: Internal and external areas well lit for safety and CCTV.
- Ventilation: Artificial ventilation provided to prevent nuisance.

4. The Prevention of Public Nuisance

Noise Control

- Music: No amplified music or speech between 23:00 and 05:00 hrs.
- The main customer entrance will remain open to allow for the orderly entry and exit of customers and delivery drivers during late night operating hours (23:00 - 05:00 hrs).
- All other doors and windows (including side doors, rear service doors, and fixed windows) will remain closed at all times between 23:00 and 05:00 hrs, except for brief moments required for access/egress or in case of emergency.
- This ensures that noise from the interior (kitchen extraction, staff, customers) does not escape into the street, and that external noise does not enter.
- The two SIA door supervisors will actively ensure that the main entrance is not left propped open unnecessarily and that customers do not linger in the doorway, which would allow noise to escape.
- Prominent signage / notices at exits requesting customers to leave quietly.

Dispersal & Transport

- Taxi Coordination: Clear signage for taxi ranks. Staff verbally inform departing customers of transport options.
- Orderly Exit: Two SIA staff ensure customers do not congregate in large groups outside.
- Litter Management: Waste receptacles provided and emptied regularly. Immediate vicinity monitored and cleared.
- Deliveries: All deliveries during opening hours only. Drivers instructed to switch off engines.

Smoking

- No smoking areas allocated within the premises. Customers directed to smoke away from entrances.

5. The Protection of Children from Harm

Age Restrictions

- Under 18s: No persons under 18 permitted on the premises after 23:00 hrs.
- Proof of Age: "Challenge 25" policy for any age-restricted items (none sold).

Safeguarding

- Environment: Monitored to ensure appropriateness for families before 23:00 hrs.
- Supervision: Staff trained to identify unsupervised children.
- No Gaming: No gaming machines or age-restricted entertainment.
- Reporting: Staff trained to recognise indicators of CSE and modern slavery.

Summary of Key Changes for the Variation

- Hours: Extended from 03:00 to 05:00 hrs.
- Security: Upgraded to 2x SIA Door Supervisors (23:00 - 05:00 hrs) to manage the extended dispersal period.
- Track Record: Emphasised 12 month clean history.
